Deflection Responses to Behavioral Health Challenges are *Centered in the Community*

Deflection – Creating Pathways to Treatment, Services, and Recovery

- An early, "upstream" approach Deflection is prevention:
- Moving away from justice system without having entered it
- <u>Behavioral health guided</u> with criminal justice partnerships alongside
- Crime reduction and well being both Better public safety and public health
- <u>Reduces the "Social Burden"</u> placed on the police

First Responder Deflection Programs IN RESPONSE TO THE OPIOID CRISIS



Deflection is a strategy designed to save lives and keep individuals out of the justice system by providing <u>pathways</u> to treatment for those with substance use disorder (SUD) and other conditions. Its use has grown dramatically since fentanyl and other synthetic opioids became more accessible (see chart). The Center for Health and Justice (CHJ) at TASC and NORC partnered on a survey and report of more than 300 first responder agencies and their use of deflection.
