Kandrevas, Director, Department of Public Services, forwarding the current map that displays the condition of roadways, as well as by Commission district, a list of repair and construction projects planned and underway, the timing and projected cost of those projects, the number of lane miles paved and reconstructed and the number of potholes filled, pursuant to Enrolled Ordinance No. 2022-675, page 19, item 2. - 2. Communication dated October 21, 2022 (received January 24th) requesting Commission approval of the Department of Public Services, Parks Division, 5-Year Parks and Recreation Plan; the term of the plan is from January 1, 2023 through December 31, 2027. (2023-60-006)

Communication dated November 21, 2022 (received January 5th) requesting Commission approval of Amendment No. 2 to a one-year purchase order terms and conditions contract with a one-year option to renew between the Charter County of Wayne and Cadillac Asphalt, LLC (of Farmington Hills) not to exceed \$15,000,000, exercising the option to renew for the purchase and delivery of hot mix asphalt to various job sites; the County Executive advises that the funds will cover the estimated quantities of hot mix asphalt that will be needed for resurfacing 125 lane miles in 2023; Amendment No. 2 increases the total contact not-to-exceed amount from \$10,500,000 to \$25,500,000; the term of Amendment No. 2 is from January 20, 2023 through January 19, 2024; the cost of the Amendment No. 2 will be charged to Account No. 201 44906 778000 (Roads-Road Maintenance). Communication dated November 21, 2022 (received January 18th) requesting Commission approval of an intergovernmental agreement between the Charter County of Wayne and the City of Dearborn not to exceed \$176,656 for improvements to Morningside Park; the County Executive advises that the funding for this project is identified in the Fiscal Year 2020-2022 Commission's Park Millage allocation; the term of the agreement will commence upon Commission approval through September 30, 2024; the cost of the agreement will be charged to Account No. 208 44935 817000 (Parks-Millage Capital Improv). - 5. Communication dated January 5, 2023 (received January 17th) requesting Commission approval of a three-month contract with two, one-year options to renew between the Charter County of Wayne and Shelving + Rack Systems, Inc.
