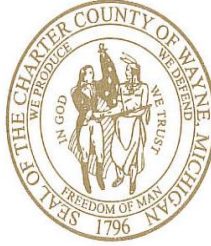

E. New Business

1. Communication dated November 29, 2022 (received January 24th) requesting Commission approval Amendment No. 1 to a three-year, sub-recipient contract between the Charter County of Wayne and Southeast Michigan Community Alliance (SEMCA) (of Taylor), with no change in the dollar amount, adding language for subcontractor approval and spending requirements, to implement the Workforce Development Programs: Subsidized Training & Employment Program, Career Navigator Program, Return to Work Program and Underrepresented Workers Assistance Grant Program; the County Executive advises that SEMCA is a non-profit organization that administers various human services programs in and out of the County and is committed to its vision for a competitive economy that is sustained by private and public partnerships that develop a productive workforce; the cost of the contract remains not to exceed \$50,000,000; the term of the contract remains from November 3, 2022 through June 30, 2026; the cost of the contract will continue to be charged to Account No. 299 89903 815000 (Workforce Development Programs). 2. Communication dated October 27, 2022 (received January 27th) requesting Commission approval of amendments to the Program Years 2020 and 2021 Annual Action Plans that were submitted by the Charter County of Wayne to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development to cover \$240,000 in bid overages for three Community Development Block Grant projects, with money being transferred from Program Year 2018 funds that went unutilized; the term of the Program Year 2020 Annual Action Plan remains from July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021 and the term of the Program Year 2021 Annual Action Plan remains from July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022; the cost of the amendments will be charged to Account No. 275 82218 954173 (Projects 2018). 3. Communication dated November 15, 2022 (received January 24th) requesting Commission approval of Amendment No. 1 to the Annual Action Plan for the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), with no change in the dollar amount, to revise the Annual Action Plan to change the funding to different participating municipalities; the amount of the action plan remains \$8,850,981; the term of the Program Year 2022 Annual Action Plan remains from July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023; the revenue from the grants will continue to be deposited into Account Nos. 275 82222 529000 (\$5,250,312 CDBG Projects 2022), 250 69122 529000 (\$3,122,427 Home Projects-PY 22) and 275 83522 529000 (\$478,242 ESG-Project Year 2022). 4. Communication dated November 17, 2022 (received December 20th) requesting Commission approval of an agreement between the Charter County of Wayne and Samaritas (of Detroit) in the amount of \$216,697 to support the Emergency Rental Assistance Program (ERAP) Vulnerable Resident Support Program (EVRSP) to provide assistance to vulnerable Wayne County residents via programs managed by non-profit partner agencies; the County Executive advises that the EVRSP extension program allows the County to reach additional vulnerable populations with services not currently being offered through ERAP but eligible under American Rescue Plan Act regulations; the term of the agreement will commence upon Commission approval through June 30, 2023; the cost of the agreement will be charged to Account No. 291 89091 952015 (ARPA EDD-ERAP2 GRANT).
